Musical Theatre West is one of Southern California's oldest musical theatre companies. Now in its 53rd year, the company has garnered national recognition and critical acclaim. Seven years ago, Musical Theatre West became a resident company at the Carpenter Performing Arts Center, presenting four major productions each year along with a Summer Youth Conservatory, a Holiday Show and numerous special events. Each show is produced locally giving aspiring talent the opportunity to perform alongside seasoned professionals.

Musical Theatre West productions play to capacity crowds and rave reviews. In the last two years the company has won LA Stage Alliance Ovation Awards for Best Musical Ensemble, Best Supporting Actress and Best Actor in a musical.

An important outreach to the community is the Youth Cultural Enrichment Program which introduces over 10,000 students annually to the joy and magic of musical theatre. Special performances of our shows are given for the schools, and cast members also visit the classrooms providing an insight into the world of theatre. The laughter and applause from these youngsters indicate it is an art form they will enjoy for many years to come.

Musical Theatre West is dedicated to preserving musical theatre as a unique American art form and enriching the cultural life of Southern California through the presentation of established musicals, the development of new works, and the expansion of our Youth Cultural Enrichment Program.
