All performances take place at the Carpenter Performing Arts Center, 6200 Atherton Street, Long Beach, 90815 (near the corner of Palo Verde Avenue; northeast corner of CSULB Campus). Programming is subject to change. Every person in the group must have a ticket in-hand to be admitted.

Due to the overwhelming number of responses received each season, we request that each group be prepared to bring students to only one performance. Different groups from the same school may attend multiple performances, but we ask that each student attends only one performance to ensure as many students have the opportunity to attend, as possible.

Cost:
