Now in its 19th year, *Broadway in the Park* attracts over 500 attendees who are wined, dined and entertained 'Under the Stars'. The evening also includes an impressive silent and live auction and that's where **we need your help!**

The performances feature Broadway and Hollywood talent but also serve as a training ground for young performers, many of whom have gone on to successful careers in the arts. This combination of professional and developing talent is the heart of the MTW mission.

About Broadway in the Park, Our Signature Fundraising Event

Broadway in the Park is one of Long Beach's most elegant fundraising events. Held in the prestigious Park Estates neighborhood of Long Beach, the event consistently draws over 500 guests for an evening of dining and entertainment under the stars. VIP guests are treated to a special pre-party reception hosted by the Musical Theatre West Footlighters. Guests then enjoy an elegantly catered dinner in an intimate culde-sac surrounded by lush decorations and thousands of twinkling lights. Between courses, guests visit the backyards of nearby homes to be awed by the previews of the upcoming season's shows. Complimenting the entertainment are the exciting silent and live auctions.

Broadway in the Park primarily supports Musical Theatre West's Education/Outreach programs which reach over 17,000 schoolchildren annually, helping to fill the critical void in Arts Education in our public schools.

Student Matinee Performances

Since 1991 MTW's Education and Outreach Program has held special weekday performances to introduce over 168,000 children to live musical theatre. This program is offered at little to no cost to the schools and, with the cuts in arts education, many of the students have never been to the theatre or have never experienced a live production. Based on the feedback from the teachers and students, it is an experience the students will long remember!

Classroom Visits

MTW sends out a teaching artist to the schools who attend our Student Matinee Performances. These workshops align with the California Visual and Performing Arts Standards to provide students a deeper understanding of the production. Many teachers report that the classroom visits are engaging and informative, providing the students with a break from their daily routine.

Traveling Theatre Productions

Throughout the year MTW sends specially-written productions into the schools senior centers, libraries, and the parks and recreation centers around the area. Each production is roughly 45 minutes long and features songs from popular Broadway musicals. These productions demonstrate both the educational and entertainment value of musical theatre.

Summer Youth Conservatory

MTW offers a three-week summer camp for students wishing to get more education in theatrical arts. The camp teaches the basics of musical theater and allows for students to grow in their passion for the stage. The students perform in a live production at the conclusion of the conservatory.

Residency at Local Schools

At their request, MTW has produced musical productions at several local schools. We bring in professionals in the industry to teach the students what it is like working on a live production. The students experience every aspect of theatre and are given the opportunity to perform for their friends and family. Over the past few years we have been able to produce five musicals at Wilson High School and two shows at Minnie Gant Elementary School. We are actively seeking other schools that request assistance in bringing musical theatre to their campus.

High School Scholarships

Each year, the MTW Footlighters award scholarships to local high school students. Since the inception of the program 13 years ago, over \$72,000 in scholarships have been awarded to deserving students. We are particularly honored that since the inauguration of the NHSMT Awards in New York City, MTW Scholarship Winners have won four out of the nine years.
