

How do I apply?

Teachers are in charge of nominating their students. They can select up to five students within each category of **Vocal, Dance, and Technical Theatre**. Nominated students receive the scholarship application packets from their teachers. From there, it is the student's job to submit the application, sign-up for an audition, and complete any other responsibilities given to them (attending rehearsals, communicating with the Education Outreach Department, etc.).

How do I nominate my students?

First, please make sure that we are in communication with your school and department leads. Our first informational session for interested applicants occurs around late January or early February, but we want to be in contact with your department leads and visit your school's performances as much as possible before then. In the Spring, we will send out application packets and instructions – please ensure we have adequate email addresses from your teachers!

School departments on our list also receive information about our Master Classes and the schedule of events for the Scholarship program.

Our Scholarship Committee works tirelessly to support your productions through show visits and placing ads in your school programs. A good relationship between your school department and our committee is our #1 priority in ensuring we are reaching and awarding scholarships to our deserving and talented student artists across Southern California.
