Responsibilities:

- Work with Junior Ambassadors during monthly meetings to create an art piece or performance that will be presented at the end of the year

Requirements:

- You must be enrolled in grades 6-8 in an LBUUSD or Greater Long Beach area school
- Be passionate about the Arts!
- Have an interest in serving your community and student theatre/arts community
- Attend a minimum of 5 of the 8 meetings
- Attend at least 1 of the 2 special group MTW performances/events offered: either **(1)** a performance of *Hello, Dolly!* and participate in a special behind-the-scenes access opportunity or **(2)** a performance of *In the Heights* and participate in a special behind-the-scenes access opportunity.

Meeting locations will be at the MTW Reiner Rehearsal Hall and run about an hour.
